POW/MIA Chair of Honor

WHEREAS, Auburn University was named as one of the 2018/2019 Military Friendly Schools with approximately 350 student veterans on campus, 1100 students receiving the GI Bill assistance, and ROTC programs that were established in 1916; and,

WHEREAS, Auburn University is the only university in the state to have all four branches of the armed forces - Air Force, Army, Navy, and Marine Corps - represented in our ROTC programs; and,

WHEREAS, The Auburn Creed emphasizes this support for our Country stating, "I believe in my Country, because it is a land of freedom and because it is my own home..."; and,

WHEREAS, A POW/MIA Chair of Honor would remain perpetually empty to help people remember that even though our soldiers are not here, there is still a space for them to call home; and,

WHEREAS, The POW/MIA Chair of Honor, in alignment with the POW/MIA mission, will "*demonstrate continuing commitment to the goal of the fullest possible accounting of all personnel not yet returned to American soil*"; and,

WHEREAS, The POW/MIA Chair of Honor is a part of stadiums across the SEC, including The University of Kentucky, The University of Tennessee, The University of Florida, The University of Alabama, Texas A&M University, Louisiana State University, and Mississippi State University. Also, Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta, Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, Gillette Stadium in Boston, and West Point Military Academy have a POW/MIA Chair of Honor in their stadium to remind fans of the brave soldiers who will never be forgotten; and,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, we, the Auburn University Student Senate, recognize the sacrifices made by our soldiers and ask the University to display the POW/MIA Chair of Honor on November 2nd in Jordan-Hare Stadium for the military appreciation game to serve as a reminder that prisoners of war or those missing in action will not be forgotten.
