WHEREAS, the University has begun to move forward with the idea of the implementation of a new “visual identity system” for Auburn University in efforts to elevate the brand; and,

WHEREAS, the unexpected unveiling of this new identity system to the students, alumni, administration, and other entities has received negative feedback which should never be associated with our logo; and,

WHEREAS, a preliminary effort was made to garner student input on this topic at a meeting on December 3rd, 2018, but officials did not reach out again, although students were told that another meeting would be called; and,

WHEREAS, many businesses and departments on campus cannot move forward with certain projects and initiatives because of the uncertainty of the status of this proposed change; and,

WHEREAS, in this transitional period of leadership for Auburn University, the student body feels that this initiative should not be at the forefront of our worries as a University as we are dealing with issues that are more pressing in our region;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, We, the Auburn University Student Senate, ask that any progress on the new visual identity system come to a halt and ask that future decisions of this magnitude consider the input of the student body and the surrounding Auburn family.

WHEREAS, Exercise is Medicine On-Campus (EIM-OC) is a program that promotes physical activity as an essential part of health, and aims to make physical activity assessment and promotion a standard in clinical care; and,

WHEREAS, Auburn University's EIM-OC has been recognized as a Gold Level Campus for the year 2019, a status only fifty-five out of more than two hundred universities and colleges obtained; and,

WHEREAS, October is recognized as EIM-OC Month by universities and colleges globally to promote physical activity through but not limited to: 5 km walks/runs, sports tournaments, daily walks with provost, and health/fitness tip sessions; and,

WHEREAS, in October 2015 Auburn University held EIM-OC Month in collaboration with Campus Recreation, The Auburn University Med Clinic, The School of Kinesiology, The School of Pharmacy, Health Promotion and Wellness Service, Student Counseling Services, and Campus Dining. During this month, the aforementioned organizations held sessions that promoted physical activity and educated students on the mental and physical health benefits of exercise;
