Inclusion of Flunch Availability on Syllabi

WHEREAS, in the fall of 2019, the Auburn Student Government Association, in partnership with Tiger Dining, launched an initiative known as Flunch; and,

WHEREAS, Flunch stands for “faculty-student lunch” and is a program where undergraduate students can request to get lunch with any faculty or staff member, made possible by a gift from Dr. Fred Kam and Tiger Dining, at either Village Dining or Foy Dining; and,

WHEREAS, Flunch was created in the hopes of encouraging students to create meaningful professional relationships with their instructors outside of the classroom; and,

WHEREAS, these relationships would prove beneficial to students in need of letters of recommendation for graduate schools, professional schools, or other career opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, since its birth, Flunch has been met with great interest from students and faculty/staff, with over 100 participants so far, but some remain unaware of how to utilize the program and the benefits that could ensue; and,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, we, the Auburn University Student Senate, ask that all instructors include their availability for Flunch on their syllabi, and encourage students to participate in the program; and,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, we, the Auburn University Student Senate, ask that instructors put this statement in their syllabi: “Flunch is an SGA initiative designed to foster better relationships by providing a meal, free of charge, to faculty/staff members and students. Flunch is a great way for students to ask questions, establish connections, and get to know faculty/staff members. To request a Flunch, please visit aub.ie/flunch.”
