6. Peter: What did you mean by 4.0's registering early and cheating with ProctorU exams?
7. Stubbs: When testing on Proctor U, it is a lot easier to cheat on an outside-the-classroom test than an inside-the-classroom test. Looking to spread awareness of the misuse and cheating with Proctor U and to promote academic excellence.
