





303.9.1 The ~~Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion~~ Access, Engagement, and Opportunity Committee shall have the following duties:

- 303.9.1.1 To consider the needs and interests of Auburn students in regard to ~~diversity, equity, and inclusion~~ access, engagement, and opportunity and take action by working to create policy and conditions to meet those needs and interests;
- 303.9.1.2 To keep Auburn students informed of those policies and conditions;

- 303.9.1.6 To work with the appropriate counterparts within the Student Government Association that represents the diverse student body of Auburn University
- 303.9.1.7 To create and present presentations on the Senate floor about ~~diversity, equity, and inclusion~~ access, engagement, and opportunity and how it relates to the cultural climate of Auburn University;
- 303.9.1.8 To break into subcommittees to target specific issues relating to underserved populations within the student body of Auburn University.







Commendation for Auburn University Athletes at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games

WHEREAS, the Olympic Games is an international multi-sport event where the premier athletes of each nation compete in a celebration of dedication and unity, and;

WHEREAS, the Olympic Games take place once every four years, and the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad took place during the summer of 2024 in Paris, France, and;

WHEREAS, 11 current or former Auburn University athletes competed in the 2024 Olympic Games, representing 10 different countries in 6 different sports, and;

WHEREAS, Kanyinsola Ajayi, member of the Auburn University Track and Field Team, represented Nigeria in the 100-meter dash and the 4x100 meter relay, qualifying for the semi-finals with the fastest time in his heat, and;

WHEREAS, Favour Ashe, member of the Auburn University Track and Field Team, represented Nigeria in the 100-meter dash and the 4x100 meter relay, placing sixth in the semi-finals, and;

WHEREAS, Makanakaishe Charamba, member of the Auburn University Track and Field Team, represented Zimbabwe in the 200-meter dash, finishing 8th in the world, and;

WHEREAS, Marcelo Chierighini swam for Brazil in the 4x100 freestyle relay as his team finished 10th in the world, and;

WHEREAS, Azeem Fahmi, member of the Auburn University Track and Field Team, represented Malaysia in the 100-meter dash, and;

WHEREAS, Emily Hallifax, an incoming first-year at the time of the Games and current member of the Auburn University Swim and Dive Team, represented France in women's synchronized diving, finishing 8th in the world, and;

WHEREAS, Sunisa Lee represented the United States of America in women's gymnastics, competed in the team, all-around, uneven bars, beam, and floor events, securing a gold medal in the team competition, and further distinguishing herself by earning a bronze in the uneven bars and all-around categories, and;

WHEREAS, Tim Puetz represented Germany, reaching the men's tennis doubles quarterfinals, and;

WHEREAS, Valerie Tarazi represented Palestine in the women's swimming 200 individual medley, and;

WHEREAS, Donald Thomas, appearing in his fifth Olympic Games, competed in the high jump while representing the Bahamas, and;

WHEREAS, JT Thor helped lead the South Sudan "Bright Stars" to their historic first ever appearance in men's basketball.
